Customer-specific

Careers in Colorado salary detail

- Bug: Participants navigating the Careers in Colorado tool occasionally did not see job information (including salary, job openings, and growth rate) populate after clicking on multiple jobs. This issue occurred primarily after clicking on three consecutive jobs, with the information not populating for the third
- ❖ Fix: Participants will now always see salary, job openings, and growth rate information as expected for any job clicked on in the Careers in Colorado tool

Bugs addressed

Tools widget display

- Bug: For clients without Tools enabled, the Tools widget was previously appearing on participant dashboards
- Fix: If a client does not have Tools enabled, the Tools widget will no longer appear on participant dashboards

Enrollment widget count

- ❖ Bug: Professionals viewing the Enrollment count on the Participant Activity widget on their dashboard were previously not seeing an accurate number
- * Fix: Professionals will now see an accurate Enrollment count on their dashboard

Referral editing and deletion

- ❖ Bug: Professionals navigating a client instance with only the Professional Portal enabled who navigated to In-Network Referrals Resources within their Client Settings were previously unable to delete resources or update their visibility
- ❖ Fix: All professionals can delete resources or mark them as visible or not visible within Client Settings as expected

Agency Admin permissions

Bug: Within their instance, professionals with Agency Admin level permissions were able to create professional users in Locations under other Organizations, create announcements that were visible to all Locations, change assessment types, and configure Community Catalog settings



*	Fix: Professionals with Agency Admin level permissions can now only make changes to professional users and announcements within their location; Agency Admins will not be able to change assessment types or Community Catalog settings
