

# New functionality and improvements

### Pinned participants filters

- Professionals who click Go to Participants from the Participants dashboard widget will see a more streamlined experience on the My Current Participants page, without the filtering options for participants
- ❖ Impact: Professionals can now more easily view all of their pinned participants



### Profile completion percentage

- Participants who view the My Profile dashboard widget will now see the percentage completion of their profile be based only on required questions
- Impact: The improvement reduces confusion about profiles being labeled incomplete when the remaining unanswered questions are not required

### **Duplicate Resources**

- Professionals who click "duplicate" on a Community Catalog Resource will now see the language following that action read "duplicate" instead of "clone", keeping language consistent across the platform
- Impact: Participants will be able to more easily navigate the platform given the language consistency



### National occupation data tooltips

- Participants viewing occupation details will now see tooltips explaining the timeframe of the data used to calculate the Estimated Annual Job Openings, Estimated Annual Growth Rate, and Average Annual Salary data points
- Impact: Participants can more easily contextualize and make decisions based off of the data they see about a selected occupation

# Customer-specific

### Truist local occupation data and tooltips

- Participants in the Truist Build Better Careers instance viewing occupation details will now see local labor market data for select occupations, and national data for all other occupations. Participants will also see tooltips explaining the timeframe of the data included in the Estimated Annual Job Openings, Estimated Annual Growth Rate, and Average Annual Salary data points as well as an indication of whether that data for that occupation is local or national
- ❖ Impact: Participants can more easily contextualize and make decisions based off of the data they see about a selected occupation

# **Bugs addressed**

# Participant widget count

- ❖ Bug: Professionals who viewed the Participants widget on their dashboard were previously not seeing an accurate count of the participants they had pinned
- \* Fix: The participants count in the Participants widget is now accurate

#### **Duplicate participant Outcomes**

- Bug: Participants who navigate to My Outcomes previously saw duplicate Outcomes when they were assigned an Outcome that had already been assigned to them and they had not yet completed
- Fix: Participants will no longer see duplicate Outcomes for those they have not yet completed. Professionals will also be notified when attempting to assign a duplicate Outcome that the participant has already been assigned the selected Outcome



The following participants have already been assigned to the selected outcomes and won't be assigned again: John Doe



# Participant header agreements icon

- ❖ Bug: Professionals viewing the participant header were previously seeing a green agreement icon indicating that the participant had a signed agreement when they did not
- ❖ Fix: Professionals will now only see the agreement icon when a participant has a signed agreement

# Program Finder matches to selected occupation

- ❖ Bug: Participants navigating to the Program Finder from an occupation in Occupation Finder were occasionally seeing long Program Finder load times and then results not matching their selected occupation
- \* Fix: After making load time improvements, participants will now see programs relevant for the occupation they selected. Programs are returned based on a CIP to SOC code mapping, so participants may still see no results where that mapping does not exist
